Current position: independent consultant. In 2004-05 Dr Gronicki was the Minister of Finance in the Government of Poland. DR Gronicki is a specialist in macroeconomics and authored/coauthored a number of articles and books. During his professional career he was a Chief Economist at Bank Millennium (2000-2004). Member of the Macroeconomic Council of Finance to the Government of Poland (1998), senior macroeconomist at CASE (1997-2000), senior consultant at the Harvard Institute for International Development- Ukraine (1997-2000), senior macroeconomist at the Gdansk Institute for Market Economics (1993-1997). In 1987-93 he worked abroad as: Chief Researcher at the International Centre for the Study of East Asian Development (CESAD)- Kitakyushu, Japan (1992-93); Consultant to the World Bank and UN (1988-1991); lecturer and scholar CERGE-Charles University (1991), University of Pennsylvania (1987-91).
